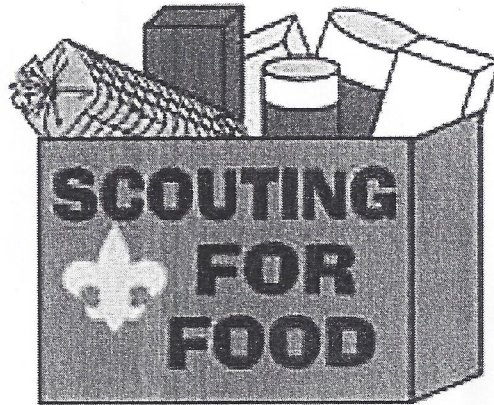




**Do a Good Turn, Earn Service Hours and
